COPS last night appealed for News of the World readers to name and shame this vile, bloated paedophile, caught on video sprawled over a bed beside his child victim. It's from a series of films he posted on the internet, showing him abusing boys as young as six. As Scotland Yard launched a global manhunt a spokesman told us: "He's white, about 40, of large build and speaks with a northern accent, possibly Manchester. Justice for Carrie as we win fight to name beast Tierney

AT last the News of the World can reveal the face of serial paedophile monster Michael Tierney—after a historic legal victory.

A month ago we detailed this child rapist's crimes but were incredibly **BANNED** from printing his photo by order of a judge—fearing publicity meant the beast would get picked on.

But we don't give in. The court order so outraged Tierney's victim Carrie Pickup that she courageously waived anonymity to describe how she suffered nine years of sex abuse at his hands from the age of six.

Angry Carrie begged us to fight the order so that every parent in Britain could see what the fiend looks like and protect their children from him.

And on Thursday she was in Warrington Crown Court, Cheshire, to see our lawyers—and a moving letter from herself—convince Judge Stephen Clarke to **OVERTURN** his own ruling.

As he did so Judge Clarke, a father of two, conceded: "I acknowledge the paper is a great campaigner against the abuse of children and it has achieved many improvements."

"The fact that an offender may receive unwelcome attention from others is not an exceptional circumstance to maintain this order. On reflection, the legitimate public interest outweighs other interests in this case."

Bizarre

Last night an overjoyed Carrie, 29, told us: "Justice has now been done and I thank the News of the World for having the guts to stand up and fight this ridiculous ruling."

"This man **WILL** try to reoffend but at least now everyone will know what he looks like to stop him worming his way into another family's life and taking their children's innocence."

Judge Clarke censured us on sentencing Tierney—6ft 8ins and 18 stone—to 18 months prison for molesting a 15-year-old boy. Tierney preyed on the lad by befriending his mum, just a year after being freed from a 15-year sentence for his crimes against Carrie—rape, indecent assault and gross indecency.

But it was the Probation Service who asked for the photo ban, worried Tierney would be the target for bullies on his release and go underground.

The bizarre decision prompted mum-of-four Carrie to give an emotional interview to the News of the World. She told us how Tierney—her mother's lover—subjected her to a catalogue of abuse at her home in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire.

"He'd wait until Mum was out then come into the bathroom when I was in the bath, or ask me to watch TV with him in his bedroom," she said. "At first I thought it was normal. When I got older he'd threaten to kill himself and the family if I told anyone."

Now I've re-

built my life but I'm worried for the safety of my children because I know what's out there.

"I still suffer night terrors. I'll do whatever I can to stop other lives from being destroyed like mine was."

We were so moved we briefed our lawyers to go into battle—just like we have fought 10 years to persuade the government to introduce a version of Sarah's Law, allowing parents to be informed about sex offenders who pose a threat to their kids.

Judge Clarke insisted he made his no-photo order to protect the public, not to shield Tierney from the press. And at Thursday's hearing barrister Myles Wilson, for the Crown Prosecution Service, said they still feared Tierney would become a target when released to a hostel at the end of his sentence, and vanish.

But our barrister Anthony Hudson said it was vital the public knows what Tierney looks like to protect their children from him—especially as Tierney had written to the court saying he wished to **CHANGE HIS NAME** to avoid attention.

Mr Hudson said: "That is a real fear. The methods he has adopted are to ingratiate himself into families."

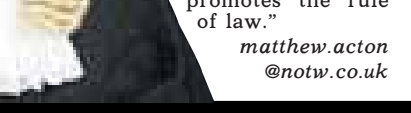
"He is a dangerous, predatory paedophile and it is of the utmost importance for the public, and parents in particular, to know what this man looks like."

Judge Clarke—who praised the meticulous way in which the News of the World had brought the case and Carrie's courage in attending court in person—said he no longer saw the Probation Service's worries as grounds for continuing the ban.

He added: "It is a well-established principle that the court process should be fully and freely reported because open justice promotes the rule of law."

the law in Sussex. In the most comprehensive study of its kind all 43 forces responded to questions submitted by us under the Freedom of Information Act.

Astonishingly 36 constabularies confessed to losing tabs on offenders—leaving the chilling fear that fugitives are out there committing yet more crimes, untold by state scrutiny.

But despite this awful threat only **ONE** force was prepared to name a monster on the run. The rest refused, citing data protection laws. This is all the more remarkable given that when names and photographs of sex offenders on the loose have

been published on a wanted website, run by the Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP) unit, 75 per cent of them were caught.

The only force willing to open up was Devon and Cornwall. It named its one missing sex fiend as vile Jason Waller.

Waller, convicted in 2000 of indecent assault against three children, vanished from Plymouth last March and is thought to have been liv-

ing rough across Britain ever since. He's 33, has a tattoo of a scroll with the word 'Joanne' on his left arm, speaks with a West Country accent and has had a moustache and beard.

Waller is one of five currently on the CEOP Most Wanted list. Last year CEOP chief executive Jim Gamble pledged: "No matter where child sexual offenders go we will find them."

But after the News of the World's damning survey this week a CEOP spokesman admitted:

"Police forces are under no obligation to publish their offenders' names and photos."

A spokesman for the NSPCC child support charity said: "It's deeply concerning so many fail to register their addresses with the police."

"Child sex offenders who go underground pose a clear risk to youngsters."

A Victim Support spokesman added: "When offenders escape like this it's a serious blow for victims and witnesses involved in bringing them to justice."

HUNDREDS of freed convicted sex monsters have given cops the slip and are roaming Britain unchecked.

A shock News of the World investigation today reveals police forces across England and Wales have lost track of a staggering 325 pervers including rapists and paedophiles.

There are 123 sex offenders on the run from London's Metropolitan force alone. The West Midlands constabulary is missing 33, 15 have flitted from Greater Manchester and ten are dodging
